WHAT IS DIGITAL SKILLS WALLET?

The project DIGITAL SKILLS WALLET develops an eco-system supported by a **digital platform** for the Acquisition and Assessment of the Digital Competence with the use of **micro-credentials** on the 5 digital competence areas as per the DigComp framework.



MICROCREDENTIALS - ASSESSMENT QUESTIONS

Within Work Package 4, Content for Digital Competence Area 1 and Proof of concept with a Large-Scale Pilot Test and in relation to **Deliverable 4.2. QUESTIONS FOR COMPETENCE AREA 1**, the Consortium has developed a total of **1672 Questions** for assessing **59 Micro-credentials** related to Competence Area 1.

These questions have been created using the authoring tool available in the platform and then downloaded and translated in all languages.

The questions are linked with:

- A Competence Area (in our Case Competence Area 1)
- A Competence
- A Micro-credential
- A Learning Outcome and Topic

Different types of assessment questions were developed, namely:

- Single Choice Questions (SCQs) - 4 answers to choose from, with only one correct option.
- Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs)- 4 answers to choose from, one or more answers maybe correct.


- TRUE/FALSE Question (TFQs) – Learners must select whether the presented statement is TRUE or FALSE.
- Put in the Right Order Question (POQs) – Learners need to arrange 4 answers in the correct order. by rearranging the statements
- Matching Question (MQs) – Learners must pair a set of statements with a set of responses.



NEXT STEPS


Short, **interactive courses** (120 in total in 4 languages) are under development.

Once the courses are uploaded on **DSW YouTube channel**. They will be peer-reviewed and subsequently they will be published on DSW platform. Courses are linked to competence area, micro-credentials (LOs) they deliver, language of the course is stated, as well as if it is related with a specific application/software and which.
