

Digital Skills Wallet Conferences Promote Digital Competence Across Europe

The **Digital Skills Wallet project** organised a series of conferences in Greece, Ireland, Romania, Italy and Cyprus, bringing together learners, educators, researchers, employees, jobseekers, employers and representatives of training organisations.

The events **introduced the Digital Skills Wallet platform** and demonstrated how it can support the development, recognition and documentation of digital competences through flexible learning pathways, short training courses and micro-credentials. Participants learned how to register, access educational content, manage their achievements and build a digital skills profile.

The conferences also highlighted the **growing importance of digital literacy in education, employment and everyday life**. Speakers addressed topics including artificial intelligence, cybersecurity, digital media literacy, sustainability, creativity, trust in digital technologies and the use of digital tools in business and learning.

Particular interest was shown in the **AI Learning Assistant**, which can provide personalised guidance, support independent learning and help users identify relevant training opportunities. Live demonstrations allowed participants to explore the platform and understand how it can be used in practice.

Feedback from attendees was highly positive. Participants valued the practical presentations, the **focus on recognised micro-credentials** and the opportunity to discuss the future of digital learning. Education providers and employers also expressed interest in using the platform to support learners, document progress and recognise digital skills.

Through these conferences, the project **strengthened cooperation across Europe** and **raised awareness** of the need for inclusive, accessible and future-oriented digital education. The project partners will continue expanding learning opportunities and encouraging individuals and organisations to participate actively in Europe's evolving digital skills ecosystem.
